2016 National Society Awards and Selection Criteria (Awarded at the 2017 National Convention in New York)

Awards in the form of plaques and certificates may be given to qualified individual members and chapters of the Society. These awards are to be presented at the national convention, based on nominations from Society members, and determined by the Board of Governors with the assistance of the Chapter Development team.

Any member of the National Broadcasting Society may nominate candidates for Society awards; however, no more than three nominations may be sent by members of a single chapter for one nominee. Follow the link to the nomination site. You can fill out more than one nomination, but you will have to follow the special instructions concerning your e-mail address for multiple entries. The nomination statement should be no more than about 100 words (500 characters) and should factually demonstrate how the nominee meets the guidelines of the particular award by citing specific reasons and examples. Activities between January 1 and December 31, 2016, should be considered for the nominating process. Unless otherwise indicated in the criteria, all award winners must have been active, paid members of NBS during 2016 and at the time the awards are presented. Nomination forms must be completed and submitted by 11:59 pm Central time, February 16, 2017.

The awards may be presented in, but not limited to, the following categories:

Chapter of the Year

Usually awarded to a Motivated or Model Chapter. To be considered, a chapter must maintain communication with the national office, increase awareness of NBS on campus, assist with applicable area and national conventions, show success in electronic media areas such as engaging in productions and providing public awareness of philanthropies, and meet all obligations stipulated in the Society's Constitution and By-Laws.

NBS Student Member of the Year

Usually awarded to a nominee from a Motivated or Model Chapter. To be considered, the individual must increase awareness of NBS on campus, participate in applicable area and national conventions, show success in electronic media areas such as engaging in productions and providing public awareness of philanthropies, and more.

NBS Professional Member of the Year

The nominee must be a professional member of NBS who serves the Society to his or her fullest and who brings positive recognition to the Society.

Alpha Epsilon Rho Member of the Year

The nominee must be a member of NBS and an inducted member of Alpha Epsilon Rho who serves the Society to his or her fullest and who brings positive recognition to the Society.

Rookie Chapter of the Year

Awarded to a chapter that has been active only since the last national convention. Can be given to a reactivated chapter. Normally awarded to a Motivated Chapter. To be considered, a chapter must maintain communication with the national office, increase awareness of NBS on campus, assist with applicable area and national conventions, show success in electronic media areas such as engaging in productions and providing public awareness of philanthropies, and meet all obligations stipulated in the Society's Constitution and By-Laws.

Rookie Member of the Year

Awarded to a member of who has joined NBS since the last national convention. Usually the nominee comes from a Motivated or Model Chapter. To be considered, the individual must increase awareness of NBS on campus, participate in the national convention, show success in electronic media areas, such as engaging in productions and increasing public awareness of philanthropies, and more.

Advisor of the Year

Usually awarded to a nominee from a Motivated or Model Chapter. To be considered, the individual must communicate well both with chapter officers and members and with the national office, as evidenced by meetings, correspondence, etc.; increase awareness of NBS on campus; assist with applicable area and national conventions; show success in advising/leading the local chapter; and, meet all obligations stipulated in the Society's Constitution and By-Laws.

Most Improved Chapter of the Year

Usually awarded to a Motivated or Model Chapter; rarely comes from the ranks of Motivated Chapters from the previous year, but may be a Motivated or Model Chapter from the more distant past. To be considered, a chapter must demonstrate a level of success not evident in the recent past, through such criteria as a significant growth in membership and greatly increased activities. The chapter must maintain communication with the national office, increase awareness of NBS on campus, assist with applicable area and national conventions, show success in electronic media areas such as engaging in productions and providing public awareness of philanthropies, and meet all obligations stipulated in the Society's Constitution and By-Laws.

Richard M. Uray - Alpha Epsilon Rho Award

Awarded to an individual, company, or organization that best represents "Excellence" in the field of electronic media. Award recipient need not be a member of NBS.
